- B1. M601, M611, and M621: All of these pages have package units on them. They are called heat pump package units by the title name. Schedule note 10 for most of them calls for hot gas re-heat. The schedule calls for gas heat on all of them. We cannot get hot gas re-heat on heat pumps. Please clarify what type of units these will be and what type of heat is needed here. Or will these units be dual fuel? Units shall be gas heat. Units specified with hot gas re-heat shall be required. Units do not need to be heat pumps.
- B2. M621: There is a chiller on this page. This would be a CGAM for us. He calls for hot gas bypass. We do not have this option. Will he approve a CGAM without hot gas bypass? Hot gas bypass is required.

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- B3. M601 and M611: These two pages have some DOAS units (Oxygen 8 as BOD). I don't see any piping on the pages with the VRF. Will these units be stand alone, or will they tie into the VRF system? DOAS units are a stand alone VRF system.
- B4. Owner shall have first right of refusal on all equipment being removed. Contractor shall coordinate with owner for desired equipment.
- B5. Contractor shall be responsible for patching and painting entire wall where wall heaters or other equipment is demolished. Paint color shall match existing in color, sheen, texture, and type.
